

Tire Redemption Program will resume on February 22, 2011

The Tire Redemption Program aimed at reducing community blight caused by illegal dumping of waste tires will resume operations on Tuesday, February 22, 2011. This City/County sponsored program will encourage local citizens to redeem unwanted tires for \$1 per tire.

To help make it even easier for citizens to find tires that can be legally redeemed for cash we now provide a list of locations around Memphis where there are illegally dumped tires ripe for pickup. We are encouraging citizens to go to those locations first to get tires for cashing in on this program. It's as simple as 1-2-3.

1. Go to the sites listed below and recover up to 100 used tires.
2. Take the tires for redemption to Mac Tire Recyclers at 3000 Elvis Presley Blvd.
3. Receive your voucher for all the tires turned in.

You are limited to 100 tires to be delivered each trip. And you are limited to two trips per day.

Residents of Shelby County with valid Tennessee identification verifying that they are a Shelby County resident may bring waste tires in a vehicle with valid Shelby County registration to Mac's Tires located at 3000 Elvis Presley beginning Tuesday, February 22, 2011 at 7:00 a.m. Checks will be mailed to the address on the ID within 7 – 10 days.

The hours of operation for this program are Monday through Friday, 7:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m. The program will be closed during inclement weather.
