

Commission Approves Optional IT Centralization

Votes Down Twitter Ban

[T]he commission voted down a resolution that would have banned commissioners from tweeting during meetings. Commissioner [Terry Roland](#), who sponsored the ban, said it was a measure to get commissioners more focused on meetings and less distracted.

He also said tweets often express political opinions. "It's not like Fox News," he said. "It's definitely not fair and balanced."

Commissioner Steve Mulroy said there are plenty of more basic distractions that Roland could have addressed.

"If we're concerned about people paying attention ... then that problem is far more on exhibit with the sidebars and the chit chat and the walking in and out of the room," he said before paraphrasing poet John Donne.

"Ask not for whom the twitter tweets. It tweets for thee."
